

Responsibility of people who own animals:

1. All pets registered at the establishment must be always accompanied by their owner and must be identified.
2. All owners of pets at the time of check-in will have to show the vaccination book up to date according to current legal regulations.
3. The person who owns an animal is responsible for the behaviour of the animal within the establishment (both inside and outside).
4. The entry of pets in areas where food products are sold or consumed and restricted areas indicated for hygiene reasons is restricted.
5. The person who owns an animal, without prejudice to the subsidiary responsibility of the owner, is responsible for damages, losses and inconvenience caused to people, other animals, things, roads and public spaces and the environment natural in general, in accordance with the provisions of the applicable civil legislation.

* The prohibitions and restrictions do not affect guide dogs when they are accompanied by blind people and they enjoy the hygienic, sanitary and safety conditions provided for in these ordinances

General rules about dogs at VILA ARENYS HOTEL:

In VILA ARENYS HOTEL, dogs and pets are welcome, except for dangerous breeds, although the following regulations must be considered:

- 4- How many dogs can there be in a room? [*Only a maximum of 2 pets per room is allowed, in any case, do not hesitate to ask us.*](#)
- 5- What things can't my dog do? [*Dogs will not be allowed to sleep on the beds, enter the showers in the room, as well as in the swimming pools.*](#)
